

INTERNATIONAL TABLE TENNIS FEDERATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS' MEETING

Minutes of a meeting of the Board of Directors held on Thursday **12 May 2011** at 09h00 in the Conference Room, Ahoy Centre, **Rotterdam**, The Netherlands

- 1. Welcome and opening address: the President welcomed all members of the Board of Directors to the meeting noting that a new deadline process for visas would be applied for future World Championships as reported at the Annual General Meeting.
- 2. Roll call: the members present were confirmed (see attached list).
- **3.** Confirmation of the minutes of the BoD held on 28 May 2010 in Moscow, Russia: the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held on 28 May 2010 were confirmed and signed.
- **4. Annual reports from commissions and working groups:** the Board adopted the following reports:

- **11. Updates of technical leaflets:** the Board agreed to consider the amendments proposed for technical leaflet T1.
